Discover

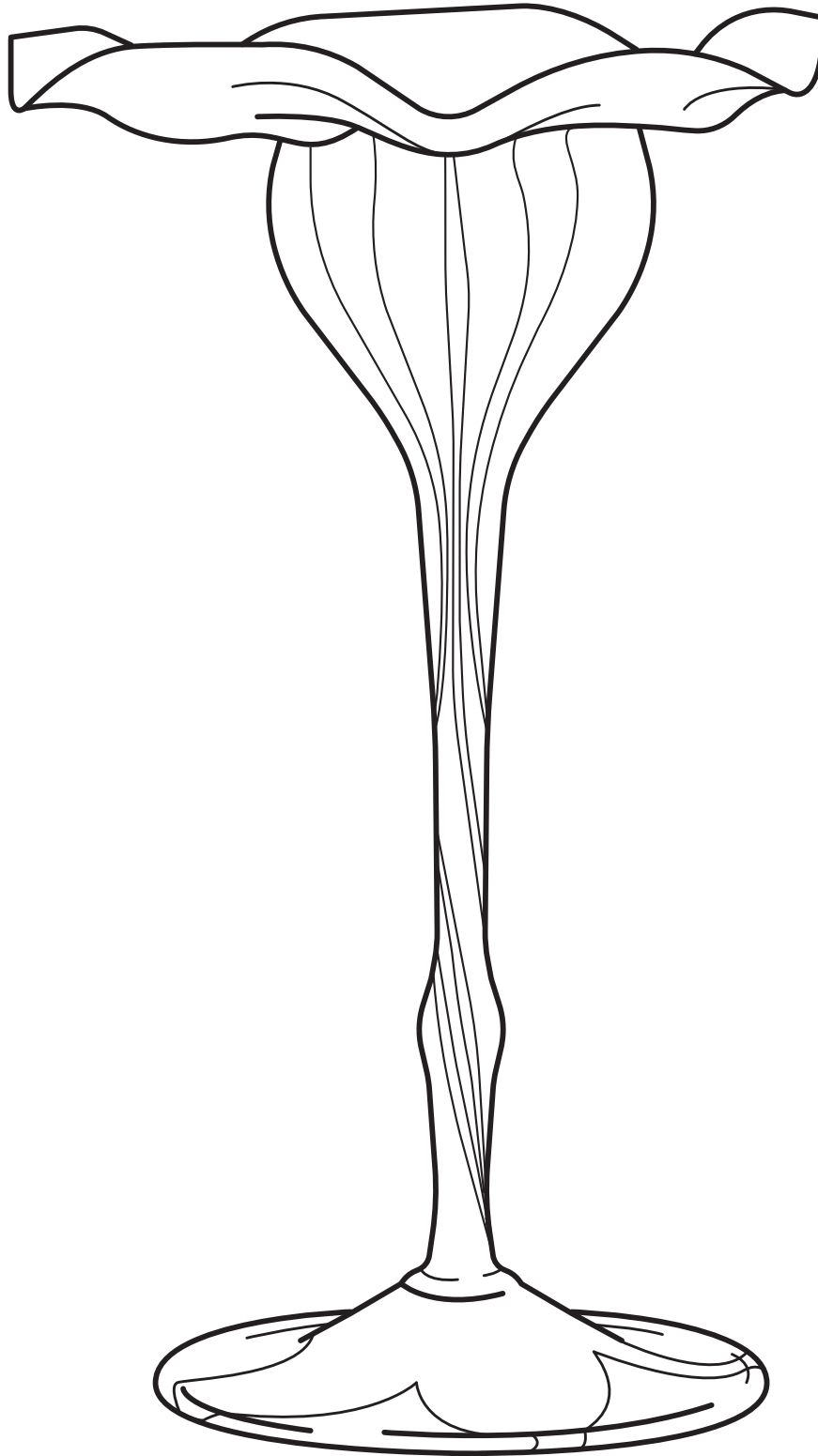
This beautiful vase is made of glass and made to look like a flower.
