Texture

Artists use different materials to give their artworks texture. Texture describes how something feels. Sometimes, artists use painting or sculpture to give the impression of a completely different texture. Look at the different textures around your home or neighborhood. **When you find an object that matches a texture below, draw the object in the box.**

Next steps

1. Ask a grown-up or a sibling to place an object in a bag. Feel the object and study its texture. Try to draw the object without looking at it based on what you feel.
2. Find several different flat objects and place them under a piece of paper. Using the side of a crayon or the side of your pencil point, gently rub over the objects. How do the different textures show up on the paper?
3. Ask a grown-up to help you search for *The Archduchess Isabella Clara Eugenia* attributed to Peter Paul Rubens and *The Emerald Pool* by Albert Bierstadt on chrysler.org. For each artwork, make a list of the different textures you see. Are there any similar words on both lists?
