

Program Cost Includes: Hotel accommodations · Meals as specified in the itinerary · Entrance fees to museums and art exhibits · Wine with included dinners · Coordination of all private visits · Group transportation as specified in the itinerary · Gratuities to local guides and drivers · Pre-departure information.

Program Cost Does Not Include: Airfare and any associated airline fees · Excess baggage charges · Meals not specified in the itinerary · Alcoholic beverages aside from included wine with included dinners · Dishes or beverages not included with meals · Room service and laundry services · Private transfers, including airport transfers to and from · Medical expenses · COVID testing or quarantine expenses · Travel insurance · Extensions or deviations from the scheduled tour · Airport taxes and/or security fees · Fuel surcharges.

Payment, Cancellations & Refunds:

Registration will close March 15, 2026. Initial deposit of one half is due at time of registration.

Double Occupancy: \$3,500 for two participants/ Single Occupancy \$2,625

Final payments must be made by check no later than March 27, 2026.

Cancellations received on or before March 19, 2026 are eligible for a refund less a \$500 per person cancellation penalty. Cancellations received after March 27, 2026 are subject to 100% penalty of all deposits and payments. Cancellations must be received in writing. There are no refunds for unused meals, accommodations, or other trip features.

Travel Insurance: We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation insurance as the cancellation penalty in this brochure will apply. The Chrysler Museum of Art will not accept liability for any airline cancellation penalty incurred by the purchase of a non-refundable airline ticket or other expenses incurred by tour participants in preparing for the trip.

Responsibility: The Chrysler Museum of Art and its employees act only as agents for the various independent suppliers and contractors providing transportation, hotel accommodations, restaurants, and other services connected to this tour. Such travel and services are subject to the terms and conditions under which such accommodations, services and transportation are offered or provided, and the Chrysler Museum and its employees accepts no liability therefore. The Museum assumes no liability for any injury, damage, loss, accident, delay, or other irregularity which may be caused by the defect of any aircraft or vehicle or the negligence or default of any company or person engaged in carrying out or performing any of the services involved. Additionally, responsibility is not accepted for losses, injury, damages, or expenses of any kind due to sickness, epidemics, pandemics, weather, strikes, local laws, hostilities, wars, terrorist acts, acts of nature, quarantine, force majeure, animal or insect bites, or other such causes.



The Museum reserves the right to withdraw this tour without penalty, in which case participants will be issued a full refund, except in the case of a Force Majeure Event. A Force Majeure Event, in relation to this tour, shall mean any circumstances beyond our control, including, but without limitation to acts of God, explosion, flood, forceful wind, fire or accident, war or threat of war declared or undeclared, acts of terrorism, sabotage, insurrection, riots, strikes, civil disturbance, sickness, epidemics, pandemics, quarantines, government intervention, or other unforeseeable event.

The Museum shall not be deemed to be in breach of these terms and conditions or otherwise be liable to you, and shall not provide any refund, by reason of delay in performance, withdrawal of the tour, or by nonperformance of any of our obligations hereunder to the extent that any such delay or non-performance is due to any Force Majeure Event. If this tour is affected by a Force Majeure Event, the Museum shall be entitled to, and may in their sole and absolute discretion, vary, or postpone the dates of any itinerary, departure date, or other arrangements in relation to this trip. The right is also reserved to decline to accept or retain any person as a member of the tour or to substitute another qualified leader or special guest. Baggage and personal effects are the sole responsibility of the owners at all times.

The price of the program is given in good faith based on current tariffs and rates and is subject to change. Any tariff, exchange rate, security surcharge, or fuel increases will be passed on to participants. The Museum does not accept the liability for any airline cancellation penalty incurred by the purchase of a non-refundable airline ticket. The air ticket, when issued shall constitute the sole contract between the passenger and the airline concerned. As part of the consideration and right to participate will be asked to sign a liability release.
